7. BOARD MEMBER / COMMISSIONER / STAFF REPORT

City of Roseville Recreation Manager, Jeff Nereson, reported an update to the proposed consolidation of Commissions.

At the November 6, 2024 City Council meeting, the Council approved the consolidation of boards and commissions into one Commission, the Parks, Recreation & Libraries Commission, effective January 1, 2027.

Nereson also presented some data retrieved for the volume of viewers of Senior Commission meetings via social media platforms which averaged about

50 per meeting. This number does not include the amount of viewing directly from the City's website. Jeff will have this figure at the next commission meeting.

Nereson provided updates about the City of Roseville's FAB Club. Including a recent Open House event, a Senior Safety presentation provided by Roseville Police Department, a Healthy Living Workshop lead by the City's fitness team, as well as highlights of various other FAB activities and programs that have been expanded to West Roseville at the Mahany Fitness Center.

Jeff also reported that this is Commissioner Knapp's last meeting and thanked her for her service over the last 10+ years. The City appreciates what she has done for seniors in the community and she will be missed.
