Summer Reading Program

Ms. Lyons, Library Assistant II, responsible for Children's programs, gave an overview of the upcoming Roseville Summer Reading Program. All ages are invited to participate. Program runs from June 4 to August 13. Goal is for library patrons to read 100,000 books over the summer. Two reading logs are available: up to age 12 and 13 and over. After 10 weeks of recording their weekly reading, children and teens will win a book prize and adults a library mug. The Friends of the Roseville Public Library provide the funds for prizes and entertainment over the summer. Over 5000 children's logs were distributed last year.

Library Report

Ms. Martin talked about the California State Library's Project Outcome resources and presented a report on Roseville Public Library's Adult Literacy program. Project Outcome compares our library's program evaluation results with other libraries in the state and nationwide. Upcoming program effectiveness assessments will include Teen Library Council and Library in the Park.

Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) were also presented. Our financial and responsiveness numbers are being negatively impacted by our stagnant materials budget and Friday closures. Library board members asked questions about the holds ratio for materials.

Budget

Budget for city is still under review. On June 4th the City Council will meet to discuss FY19 budget. City Council will vote on budget on June 20th. Due to budget cuts, the Maidu Museum and Historic Site will be closed to the public during the week except for tours starting with the new fiscal year in July 2018.
