Recommend that the Parks and Recreation Commission approve the Youth Sports Coalition's (YSC) recommendation to allocate resources from the YSC portion of funding to Roseville Pony for a storage unit at Mahan Park, two new pitching mounds and new maintenance equipment. ### BACKGROUND

The Roseville Youth Sports Coalition (YSC) is a unique partnership between local independent youth sports providers and the City of Roseville. ### RECOMMENDATION

Recommend that the Parks and Recreation Commission recognize the achievements and accomplishments of the YSC scholarship recipients.

### BACKGROUND

The Roseville Youth Sports Coalition (YSC) is a unique partnership between local independent youth sports providers and the City of Roseville. The youth sports partners provide athletic activities, opportunities and competition for participants, and the City provides game and practice fields for the partners.

In October 2009, YSC voted unanimously to establish an Annual YSC Scholarship Program where each of the seven participating leagues may select, from applications submitted to their organization, an athlete to receive a \$500 scholarship. Because there are seven member organizations contributing the \$500 scholarship, there is a scholarship pool of \$3,500. An additional \$1,000 scholarship is available to one of the nominated recipients that receives the most votes from the seven leagues. The scholarship requirements include:

- Must be a senior in High School
- A letter(s) of recommendation from a coach/teacher/mentor/etc.
- Participation in community activities, service, programs, projects
- Contribution to the league (i.e. referee, umpire, coach, train, assist, mentor, volunteer)
- Grade Point Average: greater than or equal to a 3.50
- Submit an essay on topic: "How Youth Sports Influenced/Changed My Life."

Since 2009, YSC has awarded more than \$40,000 in scholarship monies. This year, the \$3,500 scholarship pool was divided between three recipients, with the highest vote-getter receiving the additional \$1000 scholarship. At its April 28, 2022 meeting, YSC awarded scholarships totaling \$4,500 to the following students as follows:

- Shaylen McDowell, \$2,166
- Taleen Abusada, \$1,166
- Kerri Caulfield, \$1,166
