- **YSC 2019 Scholarships – Vote**

The following candidates were submitted to the Youth Sports Coalition for \$1,000 scholarship award consideration (they were already awarded their league scholarship of \$500):

Following the established voting procedures the Coalition members reviewed the applications and cast their vote on the ballot provided to them. Kristi LaRoche tallied the votes and read them out loud. Parker Armbrust received the majority of the votes (Chairman Esparza – Parker

Armbrust, GBFC – Parker Armbrust, Woodcreek LL – Parker Armbrust, Maidu LL – Troy Quinton, Pony – Troy Quinton, RYSC – Joshua Cervantes).

*A motion to award Parker Armbrust as the YSC \$1,000 Scholarship recipient was made by Chris Traina. Jason Sommer seconded the motion. The motion passed with 6 ayes.*

*A motion to award an additional \$500 to Troy Quinton and Joshua Cervantes was made by Jason Sommer. Chris Traina seconded the motion. The motion passed with 6 ayes.*

Jason Sommer asked if the coalition could award the rest of the scholarship fund.

*A motion to award Parker Armbrust an additional \$500 bringing their total scholarship award to \$2,000 was made by Jason Sommer. Chris Traina seconded the motion. The motion passed with 6 ayes.*

*A motion to award Troy Quinton and Joshua Cervantes an additional \$250 bringing their total to \$1,250 was made by Thomas Chavez. Chris Traina seconded the motion. The motion passed with 6 ayes.*

Kristi LaRoche reviewed the financial report with the members and explained in detail to the members how the funding operates. Kristi LaRoche let the Coalition know that an error was found and more info will be presented at the July meeting.
