Agenda Items: Speakers have five (5) minutes to address items that are listed on the agenda.



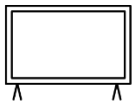

FAB being "Fifty and Better", is open to both residents and non-residents of the City of Roseville and currently has over 390 members. The program is run at two different locations, Maidu Community Center and Mahany Fitness Center.

Kiersten gave an overview of the more than 25 activities offered with membership including recreation games, support groups, technical help, daily trips and much more.

Kiersten answered a few general questions from the commission about the program and discussed ways to communicate information about FAB to the community.
