Parks, Recreation & Libraries Director, Jill Geller, provided several updates during the June Commission meeting. She highlighted the new Story Walk at Maidu Park, which creatively combines reading and nature through story panels installed along a trail—an ideal representation of the connection between parks, recreation, and libraries. She thanked the Commissioners for their participation in the Denio Family Park grand opening as it was a very successful event. She announced the start of the Library's Summer Reading Challenge, with reading logs available at all three library locations and a kick-off event taking place on Saturday, June 7, at the Maidu Library. The Roseville Aquatics Complex is now open for the summer, currently operating on weekends and transitioning to daily hours starting next Monday. Spray grounds at Vernon Street Town Square and Crabb Park are also now open daily from 10:00 AM to 8:00 PM. Concerts on the Square return Saturday, June 21, and will continue on the third Saturday of each month through September. Johnson Pool is expected to open in the coming weeks, pending final inspections, with a re-grand opening celebration to follow. Applications for the 4th of July Parade are now open, and Kathleen Beedy has contacted the Commissioners to help with judging. Lastly, due to the extended holiday weekend, the July 7

Commission meeting is expected to be canceled; however, if a meeting is needed, notice will be sent out promptly to confirm availability.
