Agenda Items: Speakers have five (5) minutes to address items that are listed on the agenda.



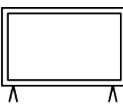

Tony Lopez, representing PRIDE Industries, addressed the Commission in support of a park naming submission honoring Michael Ziegler, who served as President and CEO of PRIDE Industries for nearly 37 years. Under Ziegler's leadership, the organization grew into one of the nation's largest employers of people with disabilities, creating meaningful jobs and opportunities throughout the region. Judd Riggs, Vice Chair of the PRIDE Industries Board, also spoke in favor of naming a park after Michael Ziegler.

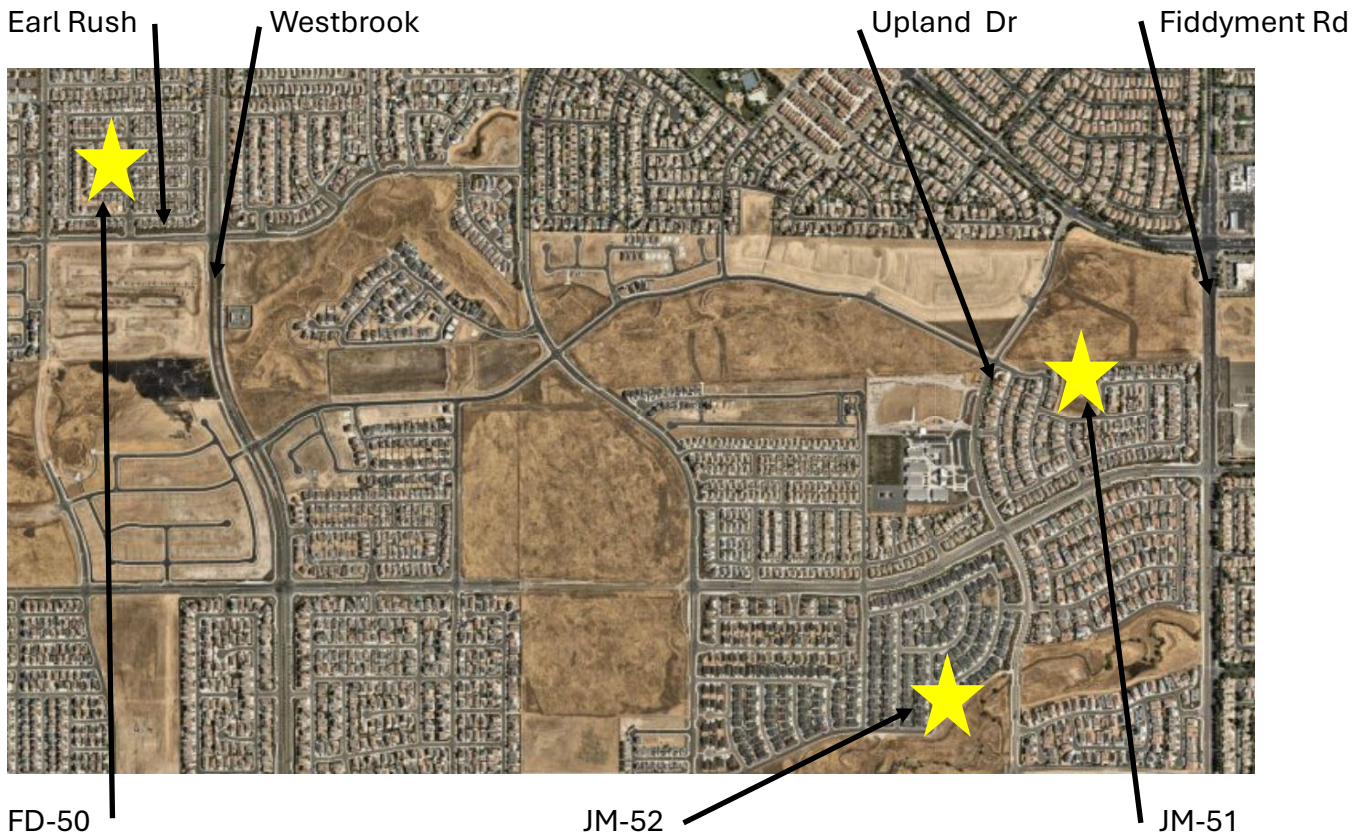
