Violation: RMC 7.12.010 Leash Law (1 count)

No person shall permit or allow any dog to run at large. This section may be cited as the "leash law."

RMC: 7.04.060 At Large Defined

"At large" means the following:

1.

Off the premises of the owner or the person having care, custody, control or possession of the dog unless such dog is restrained by a leash or adequate enclosure. The leash shall not exceed six feet in length and shall be of sufficient strength to restrain the dog and must be held continuously by a responsible person capable of controlling the dog.

Narrative:

The following narrative is regarding the specific Animal Control incident regarding the citation subject to this appeal (Citation #22391).

On August 21, 2025, at approximately 0755 hours, Roseville Police Animal Control dispatch received a call from the reporting party, Faith Oddo, to report that she and her dog were attacked by an off-leash Pitbull at Saugstad Park. Faith advised dispatch that she her dog were not injured.

At approximately 0948 hours, Animal Control Officer (ACO) Sammons spoke with Faith who provided the following statement: Faith brought her Basset Hound dog to Saugstad to use the dog park. Faith was walking towards the dog park when she observed a male, later identified as Mark Ormes, walking with a Pitbull type dog near the entrance gate to the dog park with his dog off leash. Faith stated the Pitbull did a 180, got low to the ground and ran at her and her dog. The Pitbull type dog pinned her Bassett Hound to the ground and was shaking its head. The Pitbull let go of her Bassett Hound and Faith was using her feet to try to kick/ keep the Pitbull away while doing circles with her Bassett Hound on leash to create distance. Faith stated the male owner of the Pitbull came running and was trying to grab the Pitbull by the harness. Faith stated there was an additional female who was inside the dog park with her two dogs that was also trying to grab the Pitbull, however her two dogs than got loose and Faith was being circled by

all three dogs. Once the dogs were separated, the owner of the Pitbull placed his dog on a leash. Faith requested a citizen's citation against the male Pitbull owner for leash law and aggressive behavior.

At approximately 1233 hours, ACO Sammons contacted Pitbull owner Mark Ormes via telephone. Mark provided the following statement: This morning Mark brought his dog "Kanny" to Saugstad to use the dog park. As Mark approached the entrance to the dog park he let "Kanny" off leash. Mark thought "Kanny" would run into the dog park where his friend was located with her two dogs. Mark did not know that Faith was behind him on the walking path. "Kanny" instead took off towards Faith and her dog. Mark stated a scuffle ensued between the two dogs and he was doing everything that he could to contain "Kanny" and at one point she slipped out of her collar/harness. Mark eventually grabbed "Kanny" and contained her inside the dog park.

ACO Sammons advised Mark that Faith was requesting a citizen's citation be issued for leash law and aggressive behavior. Citation # 22391 was forwarded to the City Attorney's office for review, including one count of licensing on this citation because "Kanny" was not licensed.

On or around September 30th, Mark paid the administrative fines for licensing and aggressive behavior. The only violation subject to this appeal is RMC 7.12.010, Leash Law.

No person shall permit or allow any dog to run at large.

Additional Information: RMC Section 7.04.060 defines "at large" as follows:

A. "At large" means the following:

1. Off the premises of the owner or the person having care, custody, control, or possession of the dog unless such dog is restrained by a leash or adequate enclosure. The leash shall not exceed six feet in length and shall be of sufficient strength to restrain the dog and must be held continuously by a responsible person capable of controlling the dog.

2. On the premises of the owner or the person having care, custody, control, or possession of the dog unless such dog is restrained by means adequate and sufficient to prevent the dog from leaving the premises or under the control and in the immediate presence of the owner or person having care, custody, control, or possession of the dog.

Narrative:

On August 11, 2025, Roseville Police dispatch received a 911 call from Melanie Hirsch, reporting that a male and his wife were following her and her dogs and were being verbally aggressive towards her. Shortly thereafter, Roseville Police dispatch received a call from Aditya Dhar, reporting that his wife, Charvi, had been bitten by a dog and that the dog's owner was refusing to provide her information.

A Roseville Police Officer (Officer Kasch) arrived on scene and confirmed there was a dog bite on Charvi's leg. Charvi informed Officer Kasch that Melanie was walking her five dogs on San Simeon Drive; one dog was off leash and entered the roadway causing Charvi and Aditya to stop their vehicle. Charvi then attempted to pick up the dog to remove it from the roadway and was bitten. Charvi described the suspect dog as a small/medium Poodle dog. Charvi stated that Melanie was reluctant to provide information and Melanie left the scene, and that Aditya then began following Melanie which led to the call for service.

Subsequent to the incident on August 11th, Animal Control Officer (ACO) Chacon contacted Charvi via telephone, who stated the following: on August 11th, 2025, at approximately 0045 hours, she and her husband were driving home after charging their car when they noticed a woman (Melanie Hirsch) walking 5-6 dogs, 3 or 4 of them being off leash. They stopped their car due to two of the dogs running in the street. Charvi then rolled down her window and asked Melanie, why were her dogs off leash. Charvi said that Melanie then apologized but did not give Charvi an explanation. Melanie began rounding up the dogs and began walking away but Charvi "didn't want to let this go," leading her to get out of the car, all of the dogs began running at her

and one bit her. Melanie advised Charvi she owned two of the dogs and was pet sitting the rest. Melanie took a photo of the bite, apologized, and offered to pay her medical bills. This is when they attempted to exchange information, but Melanie stopped cooperating, this led to them following Melanie and ultimately calling the police.

ACO Chacon also contacted the dog owner, Melanie, via telephone. Melanie provided the following statement: She was walking her dogs as well as her sons' dogs all on leash near her residence. Her sons dog slipped its leash due to its neck being so small, Melanie had just picked up the dog when Charvi got out of the car. Melanie did not see any of the dog's bite Charvi. This is when the male half began following her. Melanie wanted to exchange information, but the male wanted her address, and she wasn't comfortable providing it, she offered her name and phone number.

At the request of Charvi, ACO Chacon completed citizen's citation #2368 on behalf of Chavi, for leash law on 3 counts against Melanie.

Animal Control is not a witness to the reported violations. The violations of RMC Section 7.12.010 are based on the statements of the complainant and appellant.
