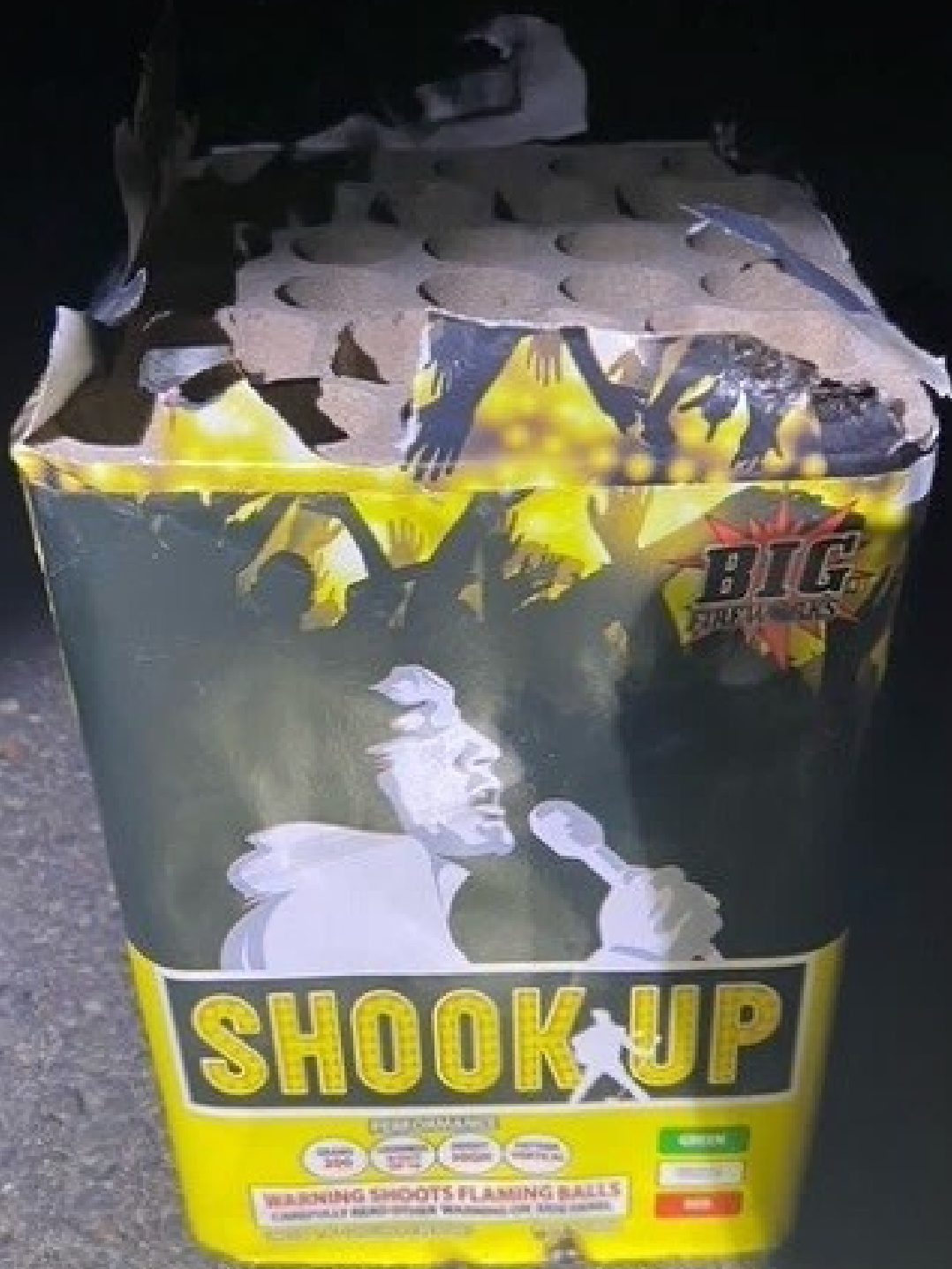

On July 4th, 2024, at approximately 8:35 p.m., Roseville Police Officer Marc Nuevo observed approximately 10 prohibited fireworks (aerial fireworks) being set off by a male subject in attendance at a gathering in front of 320 6th Street in Roseville. Using his PA system, Officer Nuevo the group that each prohibited firework was up to a \$1,000 fine, but they continued to set off prohibited aerial fireworks. Officer Nuevo performed a records check and confirmed that Gerald Ralston is the resident of record at the subject location (320 6th St.). Officer Nuevo issued a Violation/Administrative Citation for ten (10) counts of violating Roseville Municipal Code Section 16.16.140(F).

A brief video of prohibited fireworks being launched from this location was recorded by Officer Nuevo and the video footage is available for review at the request of the Board.
