Agenda Items: Speakers have five (5) minutes to address items that are listed on the agenda.



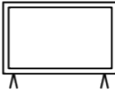

Chair Scott called the September 22, 2025 Library Board Meeting to order at 6:00p.m.

5. REQUESTS/PRESENTATIONS

5.1. Approval of May 19, 2025, Minutes.

Motion made by Fullmer to approve the May 19, 2025 Library Board Meeting minutes. Seconded by Parella. All in favor, none opposed. Motion passed.

5.2. Summer Library Challenge 2025 – Review and Highlights

Library Supervisor Cambria Evans presented the highlights of the 2025 Summer Reading Challenge. The Roseville Public Library's Summer Reading Challenge runs every summer from early June through mid-August and has the theme of "Read-Imagine-Explore". The sub-theme for 2025 was "Level up". A total of 10,900 Summer Reading logs were given out with 4,412 completions. An increase of at least 15% was seen in every category of recorded statistics. Teen & Adult first time finishers saw an increase of 46% from 2024. The library held 22 programs, including the month-long Tiny Art contest in June and Lego Contest in July. A record breaking 2000 people attended the Kick-Off party which was hosted by Mayor Bernasconi and PRL Director Geller. Total attendance for Summer Reading Challenge programs for 2025 was 26,413.

5.3. Library Teen Advisory Board (TAB) - Overview

Librarian Nathan Garcia provided an overview of the Library's Teen Advisory Board (**TAB**) and introduced members to the Library Board. TAB is a program that has been created to provide teens a place where they can socialize, obtain leadership skills, and become more connected to the library and the community. TAB meets once a month for an hour and a half to discuss how the library can better represent them through our collection, programs, and space. The Maidu Library has 26 TAB members and they held a book drive for the Summer Lunch Outreach events. The TAB at the Martha Riley Community Library has 27 members and they planned and held a Career Fair and a study hour for finals. TAB will be collecting Hot Wheels cars to benefit Toys for Tots as well as preparing crafts for Library programs. Nathan introduced Jaxon, Lynnmarie, Caitlin and Piya who are members of TAB and spoke about their experiences.

5.4. Libraries & Culture Report

City Librarian Narinder Sufi provided updates on the Libraries & Culture Division operations, including libraries, Maidu Museum & Historic Site, and cultural arts efforts. The library had extended hours during the summer months and saw an increase in visitors. The library will continue to be open for regular hours during the week of December 26-31, 2025. The Storywalk has been removed from Maidu Regional Park and parks on the east side of Roseville are being looked at for new installation. New Children's Librarian Magaly Coronado has been hired and will be working out of the Martha Riley Community Library. The vacant Library Assistant position will be filled soon. The New York Times online subscription is now fully funded by the Friends of the Library. The Maidu Museum & Historic Site will be holding Oaktober on October 4, 2025 in celebration of the oaks. The free program Walking in our Mocs will be held on October 11, 2025. The planning stage has begun for a mural at the Placer Valley Soccer Complex.
