For purposes of this paragraph, "possession" of dangerous fireworks may be actual possession, constructive possession, or joint possession.”

Narrative:

On July 4, 2025, at approximately 12:30 p.m., Officers of the Roseville Police Department were dispatched to a report of an altercation between a juvenile and adult. Upon arrival, Officers made contact with Braylen Barrette, a juvenile, who indicated to Officers that he was “blowing stuff up”. Officers then observed multiple illegal fireworks protruding from a backpack that Braylen had with him, as well as illegal fireworks protruding from his pants pockets. Braylen confirmed he was in possession of the illegal fireworks. A neighbor who witnessed the initial incident also informed Officers that he observed Braylen setting off illegal fireworks. Officers located a total of 76 illegal fireworks in Braylen’s possession and issued an administrative citation for all 76 counts of violating Roseville Municipal Code Section 16.16.140(B). The Officers’ contact with Braylen was also recorded via bodyworn camera, relevant portions of which will be shown during the hearing.



“It is unlawful for any person to enter, be upon, or remain upon the premises of any parking garage, parking lot, parking structure, or other parking facility owned by the city, unless that person is on the premises for the purpose of parking a vehicle or retrieving a vehicle.”

Narrative:

On October 3, 2025, at approximately 10:30 p.m., Officers of the Roseville Police Department were dispatched to 200 Oak Street, a City-owned parking structure, for reports of groups of juveniles drinking alcohol and racing their vehicles through the parking structure. Upon arrival, Officers made contact with Abdullah Oryakhail and instructed him to leave the parking structure. Oryakhail did not comply, and instead, went to a different area of the parking structure. Officers again contacted Oryakhail and informed him that he continued to be in violation of the municipal code and then issued Oryakhail a Notice to Appear for unlawful loitering with the parking structure. Upon review by the City Attorney’s Office, the Notice to Appear (an infraction) was administratively reduced to an administration citation for violation of Roseville Municipal Code Section 10.58.100(a), which specifically applies to loitering/trespassing within a City parking structure or facility. The Officers’ contact with Oryakhail was also recorded via bodyworn camera, relevant portions of which will be shown during the hearing.

No person shall permit or allow any dog, when unprovoked, to engage in any behavior that requires a defensive action by any person to prevent bodily injury when the person and the dog are not on the property of the owner or keeper of the dog.

Narrative:

On October 2nd, 2025, at 1959 hours Roseville Police Animal Control received a complaint regarding three dogs at the address of 1472 Arrow Wood Lane. The reporting party Sofia Ayar

reported that three dogs were off leash and charged at Sofia and the juvenile children that were with her.

On October 3rd, at approximately 1613 hours, Animal Control Officer (ACO) M. Terry contacted Sofia via telephone. Sofia provided the following statement in summary; On October 2nd, she was on a walk with her disabled juvenile son, juvenile niece, and adult niece. They were walking on the opposite side of the street from 1472 Arrow Wood Lane. When the group was approximately 2-3 houses away from 1472 Arrow Wood Lane, three dogs ran off the property, off leash, and charged at the group barking. Sofia stepped in front of her family to block the dogs from getting near them. One of the dogs jumped on Sofia and knocked her to the ground. Sofia stated that her left hip was sore. One of the dogs ran around Sofia and towards her disabled juvenile son. Sofia poured her hot tea on the dog to keep it away from her son. The dog owner called for the three dogs to return to the property and all three dogs ran back to 1472 Arrow Wood Lane. Sofia confirmed that there was no dog bite or skin broken but wanted charges pressed against the dog owner. ACO M. Terry offered to issue a citizen citation on behalf of Sofia for RMC 7.12.010 Leash law and RMC 7.12.050 Aggressive Behavior.

On October 3rd, at approximately 1630 hours, ACO M. Terry contacted dog owner Derek Koonce via telephone. Derek provided the following statement in summary; Derek owns two dogs "Maggie" an 11-year-old, spayed female, brindle, Labrador Retriever and German Shepherd mix dog, and "Tori" a 9-year-old, spayed female, tan, German Shepherd and Siberian Husky mix dog. Derek also had control/possession of his mother's dog "Luna" a 1-year-old, spayed female, tan, Labrador Retriever mix dog. Derek allows the dogs to run off property off leash on Arrow Wood Lane to "burn off energy". Derek claimed that the dogs are friendly and run up to great people. ACO M. Terry advised him of the citizen citation that was going to be issued to him for RMC 7.12.010 Leash law and RMC 7.12.050 Aggressive Behavior.
