Agenda Items: Speakers have five (5) minutes to address items that are listed on the agenda.



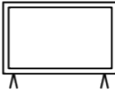

5.1. Approval of September 22, 2025, Minutes.

Motion made by Fisk to approve the September 22, 2025 Library Board Meeting minutes. Seconded by Fullmer. All in favor, none opposed. Motion passed.

5.2. Maidu Museum & Historic Site - Overview

Senior Museum Specialist Alesha Martinez gave an overview of Maidu Museum & Historic Site (MMHS) in honor of Native American Heritage Month. This

included a brief overview and information on programs and events at the MMHS. The MMHS is dedicated to the rich history of California's Indigenous people and is located on the land of an ancient Nisenan Maidu village that was inhabited for thousands of years. The MMHS provides collaborations with Native partners & exciting exhibition opportunities for artists. The Momim Wene or Medicine Water Exhibition will be on display from April 12 – September 14, 2025. Walking In Our Moccs: Perspectives from Indigenous Artists Exhibition will be on display from October 11 – February 1, 2026. The MMHS holds ongoing public programs like artists talks, youth and adult tours, Wildlife Wonders and the new OAKtober Festival. A Native Jewelry Workshop will be held on December 6, 2025.

5.3. Library Online Database and Resources – Overview

Librarian Anna Taloma provided an overview of the Library's Digital Resources. The library provides access to many online databases & resources such as NoveList Plus, Morningstar, ABCMouse Home Access, Teaching Books, NewsBank, Libby, CloudLibrary and Hoopla. New to the library are AlliedCareer, BlueCareer and Author Talks which is provided in partnership with the Library Speakers Consortium. Coming soon is Udemy. Some of these resources average thousands of visits every month.

5.4. Libraries & Culture Report

City Librarian Narinder Sufi provided updates on the Libraries & Culture Division operations, including libraries, Maidu Museum & Historic Site, and cultural arts efforts. The Roseville Public Library's collection development policy is fully in line with California's Freedom to Read Act (AB 1825). Any further changes to the policy need to be approved by the State Library. Library vendor Baker & Taylor is no longer in business. The library is in the process of setting up contracts with new vendors Ingraham and Brodart. Amazon is now providing MARC records. The Riley Shelving Project is coming soon, and the technology game cage will be removed to make room for expanded shelving. Planning is in the works to make the Downtown Library a destination of choice with easy access for all. The external stairway entry to the Downtown Library will have a mural installed. Artists submissions for this are being sought. Placer Valley Complex opened on November 21, 2025. This complex includes a playground that may be used for storytime opportunities in the future. We have applied for Lunch at the Library Summer 2026 grant, administered by the California State Library as requirements have changed from previous years. The library will hold the program, Culture Without Borders: Winter Lights Festival on Friday, December 5, 2025 at the Maidu Community Center from 5-7pm. This program will feature traditions from 9 different world cultures. December 5, 2025 is the last day to submit letters of gratitude & hope for the community art display titled "Letters to the Sky". Letters will be displayed in December on the walking bridge at Oak Street.
