3. IDENTIFICATION OF CHAIR

Chairperson for the January 13, 2026 hearing was Sharon Lawin.

4. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Chairperson Sharon Lawin led the audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

5. PUBLIC COMMENT

No one from the public offered any comments.

6. SWEAR IN

Chairperson Sharon Lawin administered the Oath to those in attendance who would be offering testimony at the hearing.

7. MATTERS TO BE HEARD

7.1. Administrative Citation No.: 22493

Appellant: Yubo Wang, 1721 Pinion Drive, Roseville, CA 95747

Roseville Municipal Code Section 9.10.200(A) – Designated Owner/Manager Not Present;
Roseville Municipal Code Section 9.10.200(E) – Display of CAMTC Certificate;
Roseville Municipal Code Section 9.10.210(F) - Toilet Facilities;
Roseville Municipal Code Section 9.10.210(K) – Window Coverings; and,

A. Staff Report:

Police Officer Erika Broussard offered testimony in regard to the Staff Report (Exhibit 7.1-A) and Notice of Violation (Exhibit 7.1-B).

Per RMC Section 2.50.060(D), the Staff Report was submitted to the City of Roseville Attorney's Office prior to the hearing and was provided to the Appellant and the panel members in advance of the hearing.

Officer Erika Broussard advised the panel that the violations for Roseville Municipal Code Section 9.10.210(F), Toilet Facilities, and Roseville Municipal Code Section 9.10.210(K), Window Coverings, were resolved prior the appeal hearing.

Officer Erika Broussard presented Exhibit 7.1-C and offered testimony regarding the following:

Exhibit 7.1-C:

- Massage Business Permit Compliance Checklist;
- Massage Business Permit Application (Renewal);
- California Massage Therapy Council Correspondence of November 22, 2019 to Yun Li Luo – Notice of Final Decision on Suspension of Certificate.

Officer Broussard requested that her witness, Sergeant Michael Hagerman, testify regarding a complaint Appellant had lodged against her.

Sergeant Hagerman offered testimony regarding Appellant Yubo Wang's complaint lodged against Officer Broussard.

B. Appellant's Response:

Request for Hearing:

Appellant's Request for Hearing form (Exhibit 7.1-D) was received by the Roseville City Attorney's Office on October 02, 2025 and was provided to the panel in advance of the hearing for review.

Xin Jiang testified on behalf of his mother, Appellant Yubo Wang, and presented Exhibit 7.1-E, in support of the appeal.

Exhibit 7.1-E:

- Roseville Police Department Correspondence to Sister Massage/Yubo Wang dated August 21, 2024;
- Copy of Title 2. Administration – Chapter 2.50 Administrative Citations – 2.50.080 Hearing Procedure; and,
- Copies of Permits for Haitao Jiang and Cuijin Xiang.

C. Rebuttals and Panel Questions:

Officer Erika Broussard offered rebuttal testimony and provided Exhibit 7.1-F to the panel for consideration:

Exhibit 7.1-F:

- State of California Department of Real Estate License Information as of 01/13/26.

Xin Jiang offered rebuttal testimony on behalf of Appellant Yubo Wang.

Chairperson Sharon Lawin asked for clarification from Senior Deputy City Attorney Travis Cochran regarding the deadlines for scheduling a Board of Appeals Hearing. Mr. Cochran stated that not following the specific provisions of the code does not invalidate the proceedings or the citation itself. The hearing was delayed due to the hearings following on holidays during the months of November and December, 2025.

Chairperson Sharon Lawin also asked for clarification from Mr. Cochran regarding the Designated Manager violation. Mr. Cochran deferred this question to Officer Erika Broussard.

Chairperson Sharon Lawin questioned Officer Erika Broussard regarding this issue. Mr. Cochran added that it is a requirement that the manager be on-site at all times while the business is open.

Officer Erika Broussard answered additional panel questions.

Senior Deputy City Attorney Travis Cochran offered information regarding the mailing of the courtesy letters advising of the Municipal Code change to Chapter 9.1 – Massage Services. Mr. Cochran advised that no notice is required by the City other than the public notice under the Brown Act for revising the Municipal Code ordinance.

Sergeant Michael Hagerman answered panel questions.

D. Panel Discussion and Decision:

The panel discussed the evidence and testimony presented for Administrative Citation No.: 22493.

A motion was made by Andrea Seminer and seconded by Charles Sandoval to deny the appeal and uphold the following citations because the City proved by a preponderance of the evidence that the violations occurred and that the appellant is the responsible party:

Roseville Municipal Code Section 9.10.030(B), CAMTC Certificate or Exemption Required

Roseville Municipal Code Section 9.10.200(A), Designated Owner/Manager Not Present

Roseville Municipal Code Section 9.10.200(E), Display of CAMTC Certificate; and,

Roseville Municipal Code Section 9.10.220(H), Client Service Records.

The motion passed with the following vote:

Chairperson Sharon Lawin signed the decision form (Exhibit 7.1-G), asked the Appellant to see staff for the paperwork, and informed the parties that they may file a petition for review with the Superior Court in Placer County within 20 days.

Appellant: Charles Sylvester

- Roseville Municipal Code Section 7.12.010, Leash Law

At 9:15 a.m., the Appellant was not present. According to section VII(A) of the rules for Administrative Hearing Procedures, if the responsible party fails to appear for the hearing within 15 minutes after the hearing commences, the responsible party's appeal will be automatically denied.

In regard to Roseville Municipal Code Section 7.12.010, Leash Law, a motion was made by Andrea Seminer and seconded by Charles Sandoval to deny the appeal and uphold the citation because the Appellant failed to appear.

A. Panel Decision:

The panel decided to deny the appeal of Administration Citation No. 22149 and deny charge of Roseville Municipal Code Section 7.12.010, Leash Law, because the Appellant failed to appear.

Chairperson Sharon Lawin signed the decision form (Exhibit 7.2-A), asked the Appellant to see staff for the paperwork, and informed the parties that they may file a petition for review with the Superior Court in Placer County within 20 days.

**Administrative Citation Appeal Hearing
Staff Report**

Date of Hearing: Tuesday, January 13, 2026 at 9:00 a.m.
Appellant: Yubo Wang, (Sisters Massage, 4010 Foothills Blvd, Ste 106)
Citation: 22493

Narrative:

On 08/12/2025, at approximately 1530 hours, Community Service Officer ("CSO") E. Broussard, Roseville Police Department Crime Suppression Unit (CSU) and EDD Associate Tax Auditor-Amy Pollard arrived at Sisters Massage (4010 Foothills Blvd, Ste 106) to conduct an unannounced massage compliance inspection. Prior to inspecting the massage business, CSO Broussard confirmed that there was a current Massage Business Permit issued to the establishment owner, Yubo Wang (2024-00000002, Valid 2/4/2024-2/4/2026) for this specific massage business and address.

Upon arrival, Yubo Wang who is the sole business owner was not present, and she did not have a documented on-site responsible (manager/supervisor) reported to the Roseville Police Department. (see attached application submitted 1/3/2024) This is a violation of RMC 9.10.200(A). Wang was contacted by phone by an employee, and she arrived approximately 20 minutes later.

Cuihua Liu was present during the inspection, I located an original CAMTC certificate on display in the lobby for Liu but she was unable to produce a CAMTC Identification Card. Haitao Jiang and Cuijin Xiang were both present during the inspection, neither had an active CAMTC and neither had an active CAMTC exemption certificate issued or on display. This is a violation of Violation 9.10.200(E). CAMTC State Law requires a CAMTC ID Card to be in possession when working and a display of an original CAMTC Certificate at each workplace (see attached)

Haitao Jiang and Cuijin Xiang were both present during the inspection. Neither individual produced a California Massage Therapy Council (CAMTC) certification or CAMTC Exemption issued by the Roseville Police Department. A check of the California Massage Therapy Council website confirmed neither individual had a CAMTC certification. This is a violation of Violation RMC 9.10.030(B). Yubo Wang, Haitao Jiang and Cuijin Xiang were all mailed letters dated 8/1/2024 regarding Ordinance Revising Roseville Municipal Code Chapter 9.1- Massage Services. (see attached) Haitao Jiang previously applied for CAMTC certification and was denied on 10/20/2017 based upon inadequate education. (see attached)

Client service records were provided however, they were incomplete. (see attached) This is a violation of RMC 9.10.220(H).

CSO Broussard issued citation #22493 for the violations noted above, specifically:

- RMC 9.10.030(B) RMC 9.10.200(A)
- RMC 9.10.200(E) RMC 9.10.210(F)
- RMC 9.10.210(K) RMC 9.10.220(A) ****Not Appealed****
- RMC 9.10.220(H) RMC 9.10.220(B) ****Not Appealed****

Violation RMC 9.10.030(B) – CAMTC Certification or Exemption

It is unlawful for any person to own, conduct, operate or maintain a massage business within the city unless all persons providing massage services at the massage business each hold an active and valid certificate from the CAMTC as a massage practitioner or massage therapist or qualify as an exempt therapist. A massage business permit shall in no way be construed to allow any person to perform massage services within the city without either an active and valid certificate from the CAMTC or qualifying as an exempt therapist.

Violation RMC 9.10.200(A) – Designated Manager or Owner Present

It is unlawful and a public nuisance to own, conduct, control, or operate a massage business unless the owner or manager designated in the application for the massage business is present within such massage business at all times.

Violation RMC 9.10.200(E) – Display of CAMTC or Exemption Certificate

The owner and/or manager shall ensure that the CAMTC certificate or exemption certificate for each on-duty massage professional is conspicuously displayed, visible from the entrance and/or reception and waiting area of the massage business, and that each massage professional has at his or her immediate disposal the CAMTC photo identification card or copy of the applicable exemption certificate at all times when working in the massage business. Such identification shall be provided upon request by a member of the public, the CAMTC, a member of law enforcement, or a city official.

Violation RMC 9.10.210(F) – Toilet Facilities

A minimum of one toilet and one separate wash basin shall be provided for clients in each massage business. The wash basin shall provide soap and hot and cold running water at all times and shall be located within close proximity to the massage rooms. A permanently installed soap dispenser, filled with soap, and a single service towel dispenser or hand dryer shall be provided at the restroom wash basin. Bar soaps shall not be used. A trash receptacle shall be provided in each toilet room.

Violation RMC 9.10.210(K) – Window Coverings

Any windows in the lobby shall not be covered. The lobby must be clearly visible from the exterior of the massage business at all times.

Violation RMC 9.10.220(A) – Sanitation

Each owner and/or manager shall provide and maintain on the premises adequate equipment and supplies for disinfecting and sterilizing instruments used in providing massages. Every portion of a massage business, including appliances and apparatus, shall be kept clean and in a sanitary condition. Appliances, apparatus, and equipment shall be disinfected after each use.

Violation RMC 9.10.220(B) – Linen

Shared use of towels or linen shall not be permitted. Towels and linen shall be laundered or changed promptly after each use and stored in a sanitary manner.

Violation RMC 9.10.220(H) – Client Service Records

Every owner and/or manager shall keep a record of the dates and hours of each treatment or service, the name, address, and phone number of the client, the name of the massage professional administering such service and a description of the treatment or services rendered. These records shall be prepared prior to administering any massage or treatment and shall be retained for a period of two years after such treatment or service. These records shall be open to inspection upon demand by the police chief, the fire chief, the building official, any enforcement officer (as defined by Section 2.50.020 of the Roseville Municipal Code) or their authorized representatives or emergency personnel for emergency purposes.

On 11/11/2025 at approximately 1330 hours, Community Service Officer (“CSO”) E. Broussard, Roseville Police Department Crime Suppression Unit (CSU) and Detective C O’Shea arrived at Sisters Massage (4010 Foothills Blvd, Ste 106) to conduct an unannounced massage compliance inspection to determine if any of the violations from 8/12/2025 had been resolved. CSO E Broussard determined the following violations had been resolved:

- RMC 9.10.210(F) Toilet Facilities RMC 9.10.210(K) Window Coverings

Re: Ordinance Revising Roseville Municipal Code Chapter 9.1 – Massage Services

To Whom It May Concern:

We are reaching out to notify you of an important change to Chapter 9.10 of the Roseville Municipal Code, titled, "Massage Services." As you may be aware, Chapter 9.10 of the Municipal Code regulates massage business activity within the City of Roseville's jurisdictional boundaries. This includes regulations regarding massage business permitting, massage business operations, and education and training requirements for massage service providers.

On August 7, 2024, the Roseville City Council adopted an ordinance that, among other changes, modifies the minimum training and education requirements for those who may provide massage services within the City. Below is a brief summary of the key changes to Chapter 9.10:

- Any person providing massage services within Roseville must hold a valid certificate from CAMTC or obtain an exemption from the City.
- If a proposed massage business will be operated at a premises that is leased or rented, the owner of the premises must be informed that massage services are being provided.
- A massage business permit applicant must submit the names and birthdays of every person who will be providing massage therapy services at the proposed business.
- Any new massage business is prohibited from operating in the same location of massage business previously closed within the prior 3 years due to criminal activity.
- Any person who has their massage business permit revoked must wait 3 years before applying for a new permit.
- Any person denied a massage business permit is prohibited from reapplying within 2 years after the denial unless the applicant can show a material change in their situation justifying issuance of a permit.

- **Massage businesses must report the hiring or termination of any massage professional (both employees and independent contractors) to the police department within 7 days of the hiring or termination.**
- **Windows that allow the lobby area of a massage business to be viewed from the exterior of the building may not be covered and the lobby area must be visible from the exterior of the massage business.**
- **Any violation of Chapter 9.10 is a misdemeanor. However, this does not require that the City criminally prosecute every violation of Chapter 9.10 as a misdemeanor, and the City still has discretion to pursue other non-criminal remedies, like administrative fines.**

Please be aware that the requirement that all massage professionals be CAMTC certified does not go into effect until January 1, 2025. All of the other requirements noted above go into effect on September 6, 2024. Also, please be aware that the City of Roseville requires a business license and a massage business permit in order to operate a massage business establishment within the City. Please contact me at the information provided below if you need assistance obtaining your business license or massage business permit.

The City takes great pride in its business community, and we thank you for choosing to do business here. We are more than happy to answer any questions you might have. Upon request, we can also provide a copy of the ordinance showing the specific changes being made to Chapter 9.10 of the Roseville Municipal Code. Re: Final Decision on Proposed Un-Approval of School

On May 12, 2016, the California Massage Therapy Council ("CAMTC") sent your school, Lincoln Institute of Body Therapy ("LIBT"), a letter notifying it that CAMTC was proposing to un-approve the school. You timely responded to the proposed un-approval letter, requested a continuance, and requested an oral presentation before the Board. You and your counsel appeared at the September 28, 2016 Board meeting and made an oral presentation to CAMTC's full Board. You also provided documents in opposition to the proposed un-approval. After careful consideration of all of the evidence in your case, including all documentation and your oral presentation, CAMTC has decided to un-approve your school.

CAMTC proposed to un-approve your school based on the findings stated in the proposed un-approval letter sent to you on May 12, 2016. Those findings can generally be summarized as follows. Statements were made to CAMTC's undercover operative by Ms. De Leon, who specifically and personally told the operative, among other things, that:

- LIBT offers a day program and an evening program. The day program was described as being from 9:30am – 1:30pm, and with an hour for lunch, and the evening program was described as being from 6:00pm – 9:00pm. Each program therefore was described as providing classes for only 3 hours a day. Ms. De Leon stated that regardless of which program was attended, the operative would get a full 8 hours of credit for classes each day;
- Ms. De Leon further stated that the operative could receive an additional 2 hours of class credit a day for "clinical" hours if the operative brought in friends and family

- members to work on, with no indication that these hours would be performed under the direct supervision of a live instructor;
- Ms. De Leon directed the operative to lie to others about the number of hours actually attended at the school, and specifically told the operative to tell others that eight hours a day were attended, even though only three hours a day would actually be attended.

Based on these statements, CAMTC proposed to un-approve your school for engaging in the following violations of its Procedures for Un-Approval of Schools: offering to sell and selling transcripts and providing transcripts without requiring full attendance at the school in violation of CAMTC Procedure section 1.a; failing to require students to attend all of the classes listed on the transcript in violation of CAMTC Procedure section 1.b.; failing to require students to attend all of the hours listed on the transcript in violation of CAMTC Procedure section 1.c.; engaging in fraudulent practices including the creation of fake documents to aid or abet students seeking CAMTC certification in addition to other conduct in violation of CAMTC Procedure section 1.d.; violating both a law and a rule of CAMTC by failing to require that all hours of instruction were provided before a live instructor and by providing hours credit for hours that were not actually attended, in violation of CAMTC Procedures section 1.e.; and failing to create, record, and maintain accurate records including student attendance records and student transcripts in violation of CAMTC Procedure section 1.g.

In opposition to the proposed un-approval of your school, you provided a written statement, documents, and an oral presentation to the full Board. In your written statement, you tried to explain the statements made to the undercover operative offering to provide 8 hours of credit for attending only 3 hours a day as being made "sarcastically and in anger, and frustration in dealing with an unreasonable prospective student." The Board does not find this characterization of the situation credible. What is clear is that you did make these statements to the undercover operative, which you have admitted. The Board notes that while the proposed un-approval letter merely stated that you told the operative to lie to CAMTC or "another authority" about the hours attended at the school, in your opposition you identify this other authority as the FBI, which is in fact the other authority the operative identified as the party you told the operative to lie to. The fact that these statements were made to the operative is therefore not in dispute. The Board finds that the statements made to the undercover operative about how LIBT's program operates were in fact made, and were made in earnest. The Board therefore finds that Ms. De Leon offered to provide 8 hours of class credit a day on weekdays while requiring attendance for only 3 hours of classes a day.

Additionally, many of the statements Ms. De Leon made to the operative are supported by the materials submitted in opposition to the proposed un-approval of your school and by statements made on your website and in your official school documents. On your school's website it describes your class schedule as follows:

"Mondays-Fridays
Daytime – 9:30 a.m. – 1:30 p.m.
Evening – 6:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m."

This schedule conforms to the statements made to the undercover operative, which is that your school has two programs, a daytime program for 3 hours a day (9:30am-1:30pm with an

hour for lunch) and an evening program for 3 hours a day (6-9pm). There is no indication anywhere that students may attend BOTH the daytime program and the evening program at the same time. Nor is there any indication anywhere that students can attend at other times, such as from 9:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. or from 6pm until 10pm. However, the documents you submitted in opposition to the proposed un-approval have attendance records that show very different school schedules than the one listed on your website. For [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] the records show alleged attendance from 9am-6pm every day regardless of subject matter.

For the other students ([REDACTED]) their schedules show attendance from 9:30am – 1:30pm and 6pm – 10pm on most days, with attendance for “Sports” from 9am-6pm. It makes no logical sense that students would be attending different schedules for the same classes. For example, the records you submitted show that [REDACTED] allegedly attended “Circulatory” on 7/23/15 from 9:30am -1:30pm and 6pm – 10pm, while [REDACTED] allegedly attended “Circulatory” on 9/1/15 from 9am – 6pm. The daily attendance records with the split schedules (9:30am – 1:30pm and 6-10pm) appear to be a fraudulent effort to create documents showing an 8-hour day, even though the hours don’t correspond to your school’s published class schedule. The same can be said about the 9am – 6pm attendance records.

Additionally the documents you submitted for [REDACTED] also do not appear to be authentic attendance records that accurately track the hours of classes attended at your school. For example, for a listing for 10/12/15 the class content is described as “Holiday.” A quick review of a calendar indicates that 10/12/15 was Columbus Day. A review of your 2014 Catalog, linked to from BPPE’s website, notes on page 17 that Columbus Day is a holiday that your school observes by being closed. Therefore your school was closed on this day, yet this student has an attendance record that shows that the student was at your school from 9am-6pm. Even more concerning is that fact that the hours for this day have an instructor sign off, and the Director of Education (“ADL” – which appears to be Angela De Leon) has also signed the sheet that includes this entry. The attendance log for this student for 12/3/15 lists the class content as “no school.” Again, the hours are listed as 9am-6pm and there is an instructor sign off and sign off from the Director of Education for this listing as well. Entries of this nature are consistent with fraudulently created attendance records executed by an individual with a limited grasp of the English language or a lack of understanding of what they were copying when the fraudulent records were created. Clearly for this student at least, your school has provided hours credit for hours of education that were not provided by a live instructor. On this basis alone the Board has the authority to un-approve your school.

While CAMTC brings the discrepancies with this student record to your attention, it is not the only discrepancy in the documents you provided. For example, the documents for [REDACTED] show a schedule of attendance generally from 9:30 a.m. – 1:30 p.m., and 6 p.m. until 10 p.m. most days, with days for “Sports” being from 9-6 p.m. The Board notes that on some days where it says 9-6, it looks like different times were inadvertently written and then whited out and written over. This adds to the inauthentic nature of the documents. As noted above, none of the daily attendance times match the class schedule on your website. While most of the attendance records for this student follow this pattern, for the last two pages of records for [REDACTED] there are no “in” and “out” times (from 9/16/15 – 12/9/15) yet

these days are still signed off by an instructor and the Director of Education. These discrepancies make it appear as if these documents were fraudulently created for your opposition to CAMTC's proposed un-approval, but the parties failed to completely fill in the documents before submission.

Likewise the documents for [REDACTED] suffer from the same discrepancies. The documents generally show a split schedule from 9:30am – 1:30pm and 6pm – 10pm, until the page of attendance records from 9/9/15 through 10/27/15, which just show an in time of 9:30am with no out time, and then an in time of 6pm with an out time of 10pm. It appears that the person filling in this page of the form failed to list the morning session out times for any of the entries on this sheet. Again, this sheet is signed off by the instructor and the Director of Education. This makes it appear as if this sheet was signed off by the instructor and the Director of Education and then given to the student to add the rest of the information, which was improperly done. Also, on the first page of the attendance records for this student there are entries for "Sports" where it can clearly be seen that a different start time (it appears to be 9:30am) was whited out, and the start time of 9am was added for the page dated from 6/16/15 – 7/28/15.

The documents you have provided therefore strengthen CAMTC's case against you and make it clear that you have violated CAMTC's policies and procedures. After receiving CAMTC's proposed un-approval letter, your school responded on June 10, 2016, attached blank attendance logs, and requested a continuance so that you would have sufficient time to submit evidence in opposition to the proposed un-approval. This continuance was granted, but CAMTC notes that the majority of documents you submitted in opposition were "attendance records" for students, which are documents that allegedly date from 2015 and therefore should have existed and been in your files on the date that you received the proposed un-approval letter. You have failed to explain why you submitted blank attendance records with your June 10, 2016 letter instead of submitting completed attendance records. You did not submit the "attendance records" for the specific students discussed above until August 31, 2016.

After carefully considering all of the evidence in this case, including but not limited to your oral presentation to the Board, the documents you submitted in opposition to the Proposed Un-Approval, and the arguments of your counsel, CAMTC finds the following:

- Your school offered to provide or has provided a transcript or transcripts without requiring full attendance at the school, in violation of CAMTC Procedures section 1.a.
- Your school has failed to require students to attend all of the classes listed on their transcript, in violation of CAMTC Procedures section 1.b.
- Your school has failed to require students to attend all of the hours listed on their transcript in violation of CAMTC Procedures section 1.c.
- Your school has engaged in fraudulent practices in violation of CAMTC Procedures section 1.d by doing all of the following:
 - Offering to provide a transcript without requiring full attendance at the school;
 - Creating fraudulent documents that do not accurately reflect the actual hours of class attended at your school;
 - Creating transcripts that do not accurately reflect the actual classes attended by students;

- Providing hours credit for hours when students are not actually present at the school attending classes before a live instructor;
- Providing hours of "clinical" credit for hours of massage provided by students that are not performed under the direct supervision of an instructor; and
- Creating fake documents for CAMTC certification, including attendance records.
- Your school has violated or attempted to violate, or assisted or abetted in the violation of, or conspired to violate a rule of CAMTC by providing hours credit for hours that are not hours of education provided under the direct supervision of a live instructor in violation of CAMTC Procedure section 1.e.; and
- You have failed to create, record, or maintain accurate records in that you are creating student transcripts that do not accurately reflect the number of hours and classes actually attended by students, and the attendance records for your students include hours that are not hours of education provided by a live instructor, all in violation of CAMTC Procedure section 1.g.

CAMTC therefore has decided to uphold its proposed decision to un-approve your school. The decision of the Board is final.

For all students that have submitted a transcript from your school and whose applications were received on or before June 30, 2016, CAMTC will notify them that they are required to provide additional proof of adequate education, beyond a transcript and/or diploma, by sending them a proposed denial letter. Applications received on or after July 1, 2016, with transcripts from your school will be notified that education from your school will not be accepted and that they have one year to complete additional education at a CAMTC approved school before their applications are purged.

On March 9, 2017, the California Massage Therapy Council (hereafter "CAMTC") issued you a proposed denial of certification letter based on inadequate education. In accordance with CAMTC's procedures you timely informed CAMTC that you were requesting submission of a written statement. On July 20, 2017, the Hearing Officers of the Professional Standards Division met to consider the documents you submitted and all of the evidence in your case.

In support of your application for certification you submitted the following evidence before the document deadline:

- **Transcript from Lincoln Institute of Body Therapy (500 hours), 10/1/15 to 01/8/16**
- **Certificate of Completion**
- **Employee Evaluations**
- **Handwritten class notes**
- **Diagrams with handwritten notes**
- **Written Statement, dated 5/10/17**
- **Letters of Reference from:**
 - **Yubo Wang, dated 5/17/17**

- Mark Borba, dated 5/7/17
- Larry Reese, dated 5/1/17
- Roseville Police Department Massage Permit
- Federation of State Massage Therapy Boards: Score Report MBLEx - Pass
- Veracity Insurance Paperwork
- 2016 IRS Tax Forms
- CAMTC Correspondence
- Email Correspondence

The hearing officers carefully considered all of the evidence in your case. You attended a school from which the transcript alone is not considered sufficient proof of adequate education. In support of your education you failed to provide sufficient credible proof that you actually attended all of the classes listed on your transcript and received all of the required education. While you submitted a massage permit from the City of Roseville, tax documents, insurance documents, employee evaluations, and letters of recommendation, these go to prove your work history, not your education. Your school also submitted materials on your behalf. However, because these documents were created and submitted by a school that CAMTC does not consider to be a reliable source, they carry very little weight.

In support of your education you submitted a written statement. Although your written statement lists the documents you are submitting in support of your education, your written statement fails to provide any other details about your education at Lincoln Institute of Body Therapy (hereinafter "Lincoln") that would have provided additional evidence of your education. For example, you failed to discuss the specific classes you took, your class schedule, your instructors, or what you learned during your time at Lincoln that would have supported that you actually attended all of the 500 hours listed on your transcript. Moreover, the hearing officers note that your home address and work location are in Roseville, California, and Lincoln is located in Orange, California. Given that Roseville is over 400 miles away from Orange, California, the hearing officers would have expected you to discuss in your written statement, the difficulty of attending a school that is so far from your residence and also to discuss the reasons why you attended a school so far away from home. CAMTC did receive a letter from Larry Reese, who states that he assisted you in finding a school to attend in your native language. He states that there were no schools in the area that taught in your native language and that the closest school was Lincoln. However, the hearing officers find that all of the documents you submitted from Lincoln are in English and it appears that the classes were taught in English. Therefore, the hearing officers find it is not credible that you attended Lincoln so that you could attend a school that taught in your native language. The hearing officers find it is not credible that you attended a school over 400 miles from your home, but provided no credible explanation for doing so in your written documents.

Additionally, in support of your education you submitted approximately 63 pages of handwritten notes. However, the hearing officers find that the notes you submitted are not consistent with notes that would have been taken in a massage class. Specifically, the notes you submitted are extremely neat and either in numbered lists or paragraph form and do not appear to have been taken in a classroom setting. Additionally, some of the notes are not

massage related. For example, there are notes relating to ophthalmology, which is a topic that would not typically be covered during a massage therapy program. Moreover, there are no diagrams contained in the handwritten notes, which would have been expected had these notes been taken in a massage course. Instead, the hearing officers find that the notes you submitted are more consistent with self-study or MBLEX preparation. Overall, the hearing officers find that the handwritten notes you submitted are not persuasive evidence in support of your education.

Finally, in support of your education you submitted a number of handouts. However, only a few of the handouts you submitted had any writing on them. Because the handouts do not have many handwritten notes on them, there is not sufficient evidence that these handouts were used during classes at Lincoln. As such, the hearing officers find that the handouts do not provide strong evidence that you actually attended all of your classes at Lincoln. Therefore, the hearing officers find that the handouts do not support that you have all of the education listed on your transcript.

Overall, the hearing officers find that you have failed to submit sufficient additional evidence of your education. After carefully weighing all of the evidence in your case, the hearing officers have decided to uphold its proposed decision to deny your application for certification in accordance with CAMTC's Procedures for Denial of Certification or Discipline/Revocation section 1.a. The decision of the hearing officers is final. The denial of your application for certification is effective on August 10, 2017. In accordance with CAMTC policy, denied applicants must wait two years from the effective date of denial before reapplying.

Prior to conducting a compliance check on the following location (4010 Foothills Blvd, Ste 106), I conducted a check of the Roseville Police Department permit module and noted there was an active Massage Business Permit issued to the owner of the business: Yubo Wang (#2024-00000002, Issued 2/4/2024-2/4/2026). I also noted the following individuals were reported as working at the business: Cuijin Xiang, Zhongchu Liang, Cuihua Liu and Haitao Jiang.

I conducted a search of the City of Roseville Business license portal and located the following active business license for massage therapy at this location: Sisters Massage owner Yubo Wang #00831407.

I conducted a check of the California Massage Therapy Council website and located current and active CAMTC certificates for the following individuals: Yubo Wang (#54650), Zhongchu Liang (#49671) and Cuihua Liu (#43632).

NARRATIVE (continuation)

On 8/11/2025, I conducted a Google search of the business (address and phone number 916-771-0333) and located an illicit ad on Bunnyagent.com. Bunnyagent is a website known for advertising of erotic massage parlors. I was unable to discern when the ad may have been posted. The ad is attached to this report for reference.

Based upon the above information, a massage compliance inspection of the business was conducted with the assistance of the Roseville Police Department Crime Suppression Unit (CSU), Amy Pollard-EDD Associate Tax Auditor, Kyle Camilleri-City of Roseville Code Enforcement Inspector I and Jim Proper-Senior Building Inspector.

INVESTIGATION:

On 8/12/2025 at approximately 1530 hours, CSU, Camilleri, Proper, Pollard and I arrived at 4010 Foothills Blvd, Ste 106 for an unannounced compliance check.

Upon arrival, I noted the business sign above the business read "Sisters Massage". The glass windows and front door were covered in reflective window tint and window cling advertisement which obstructed any view into the business/lobby. An "OPEN" sign was illuminated. The business hours were posted on the front door as well as the business number (916-771-0333).

The following individuals were located inside the establishment: Cuijin Xiang, Cuihua Liu and Haitao Jiang. There were no customers in the business.

Cuihua Liu, Cuijin Xiang and Haitao Jiang were identified via California Driver's license. I located original CAMTC certificates on display in the lobby issued to Cuihua Liu, Yubo Wang and Zhongchu Liang. Cuihua Liu did not have her CAMTC ID on her person at the time of the inspection. Liu did contact a family member by phone who later brought her CAMTC ID from her residence prior to the inspection concluding. Haitao Jiang and Cuijin Xiang did not have an active CAMTC or CAMTC exemption.

The owner, Yubo Wang was not present upon my arrival but did arrive approximately 20 minutes later after being contacted by phone by an employee.

I conducted the inspection and noted all violations on a Roseville Police Department Massage Business Inspection sheet. (see attached)

Using my department issued cell phone, I photographed the interior and exterior of the business documenting the violations.

Based upon the violations noted during the inspection, I issued the following Complaint Cite for Yubo Wang #22493.

Camilleri-Code Enforcement Inspector I conducted an inspection and later provided me a copy of the Administrative Citation Warning and resolution information. I attached it to this report for reference.

I conducted a search of the Roseville Police Department database and noted on 8/24/2021 (2021-47178) an inspection of the business was conducted, and violations were noted. Yubo Wang was the owner, and she was issued warnings regarding warning devices and lack of client registers.

On 7/27/2023 (2023-39734) a female client reported a male massage therapist, known as "Simon" inserted his finger in her vagina and placed his mouth on her vagina. During the investigation Wang initially denied knowing who "Simon" was then later provided Det. Mohring the true identity of "Simon" as Yunli Luo. Yunli Luo was an unreported employee and did not have an active CAMTC certification.

On 10/10/2023, an inspection of the business was conducted, and violations were noted (2023-55158). Yubo Wang was the owner, and she was not present upon arrival of Roseville Police Department staff. Yubo Wang later arrived after being contacted by her husband, Haitao Jiang. Yubo Wang was issued warnings regarding lack of client registers and owner not being present during business hours.

If noncompliant, provide additional details: The front door and lobby windows had reflective window tint and advertisement window cling which obstructed a clear view into the business from the exterior.

Sanitation, RMC 9.10.220(A): Each owner and/or manager shall provide and maintain on the premises adequate equipment and supplies for disinfecting and sterilizing instruments used in providing massages. Every portion of a massage business, including appliances and apparatus, shall be kept clean and in a sanitary condition. Appliances, apparatus, and equipment shall be disinfected after each use.

Proper sanitation maintained. V

If noncompliant, provide additional details: Massage room #10- unknown moist pasty substance was smeared on a shelf where a basket containing a basket of massage supplies, Massage room #11- linens were soiled/stained and a discarded band aid and watermelon see was located on the floor in a corner, soiled towels were located piled up on the dryer and soiled towels were hanging from racks above dryer, latex gloves piled up on top of water heater

Upon inspection, several violations were observed, which include, unpermitted removal of 12 walls, adding a washer and dryer to a storage room, a tanning room now being used as a breakroom, a screen door around the fire exit, insulation blocking the fire sprinkler radius in the hall and several, electrical, mechanical, plumbing and fire systems being modified or added without permits.

To be compliant with the Roseville Municipal Code, new plans for the above address need to be draw by a Design Professional and submitted to the Planning department for a new Certificate of Occupancy and an After the Fact (ATF) inspection needs to be scheduled with the Building Department.

On 8/16/2017, Massage Business applicant Yubo Wang was notified by Datha Castro of the Roseville Police Department of the following City of Roseville operating and health & safety requirements. (Reference City Municipal Code Title 9 Health and Safety, Chapter 9.10 "Massage Services")

- Yb It is unlawful for any massage business, sole proprietor or independent contractor to engage in massage therapy without a valid and unexpired Massage Business Permit.
- Yb The term of a Massage Business Permit is two years. Applications for renewal should be submitted at least 15 days prior to expiration. If an application for renewal is not made within 15 days of expiration, the renewal can be denied and the person shall be deemed a new applicant and shall have to re-qualify under the provisions of this chapter.
- Yb Any Massage Business Permit issued pursuant to this chapter is valid only for the person/business specified therein and is not transferable to any other person.
- Yb Any person providing massage services shall have a valid photo identification, proof of completion of certified massage therapy training with a minimum of 125 hours available upon request.
- Yb Massage business facilities should be readily available for inspection at all times while providing such services, and shall show the Massage Business Permit for inspection to any authorized representative of the City.
- Yb A Massage Business Permit may be suspended or revoked by the police chief when it shall appear to him or her that the activity authorized by the permit is conducted, maintained, or carried out in a manner contrary to or in violation of any law of the state, county, city, or federal government; any provision of this chapter; or any condition imposed by the chief in the granting of the permit.
- Yb The permit-holders shall be responsible for their massage therapists and themselves to refrain from working in any massage establishment, and to refrain from providing massage services, if the permit-holder and/or employee(s) have reason to believe that he or she has any communicable disease, any open wound of any nature, or any other condition which may be hazardous to the health of a patron or client.
- Yb If a permit-holder or massage therapist is found to have a disease or condition which may be hazardous to the health of a client, his or her employment shall be temporarily discontinued until reinstatement as a permit-holder and/or massage therapist is approved in writing by a licensed physician certifying that the permit-holder and/or massage therapist is free from communicable or contagious diseases.
- Yb Off-premise massage services may not be conducted at the massage therapist's personal residence.

Yb All equipment, including appliances and apparatus, shall be kept clean and in a sanitary condition. Appliances, apparatus, and equipment shall be disinfected after each use.

Yb A list of services shall be posted in an open, public place on the premises, and shall be described in readily understood language. No massage therapist shall offer to perform services other than those posted.

Yb All massage therapists shall be fully clothed at all times while furnishing massage services and must wear closed-toe footwear while administering a massage or while in the massage rooms. Clothing shall be of a clean, fully opaque, nontransparent material without holes and provide complete coverage from mid-thigh to three inches below the collar bone.

Yb Massage therapists shall not make intentional contact or occasional and repetitive contact with the genitals, anus, or the areola (nipple) of another person.

Yb Massage services shall only be conducted during the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. on any day.

Yb No person shall enter, be, or remain in any part of a massage establishment while consuming or using an alcoholic beverage or drug unless it is a drug prescribed for that individual.

Yb A massage business shall maintain a daily register of clients. The register shall record the client's name and address, the date and hours that the client entered and exited from the massage establishment, the services provided, and the name of the massage therapist attending the client.

Yb The daily register of clients shall be kept for two years and always made available for inspection by the police chief or his or her authorized representative.

Yb Massage Business Permit holders must furnish and maintain current contact information (address and phone number) with the chief of police. Any change in contact information must be provided to the chief of police in writing within 10 days of such change. Failure to notify the chief of police of the change of contact information shall render any permit void.

Yb It is unlawful for any person to audio and/or video record the massage procedures delivered to patrons or others by massage therapists. Such recordings shall include, but not be limited to, both still and motion pictures and closed-circuit television.

Yb Each massage business, sole proprietor and independent contractor requiring a permit shall include the number of their Massage Business Permit in any advertisement of services appearing in any newspaper, telephone directory, printed advertising medium, or electronic media.

Re: Notice of Final Decision on Suspension of Certificate

On March 27, 2019, the California Massage Therapy Council (hereafter "CAMTC") issued you a suspension of certificate letter. In accordance with CAMTC's procedures, you timely informed CAMTC that you were requesting an oral hearing to challenge the factual basis of the suspension. You appeared at the July 25, 2019, telephonic hearing with your translator, Karen Kam. You also submitted documents in support of your oral testimony. After your telephonic hearing, the Hearing Officers met to consider the documents you submitted, your oral testimony, and all of the evidence in your case.

Your Suspension of Certificate was based on the following:

- CAMTC received a sworn declaration from Detective Eric Bernardo of the Milpitas Police Department stating that on October 12, 2018 a massage provider working on the premises of Happy 9 Day Spa, a massage establishment that you own and/or operate, committed acts punishable as a sexually related crime. CAMTC has determined that you have committed acts punishable as a sexually related crime because as the owner or operator of Happy 9 Day Spa, you allowed acts punishable as a sexually related crime to occur on the premises of your massage establishment, you facilitated the activity, and you were in a position to benefit from that conduct.
- Pursuant to Detective Bernardo's declaration, on October 12, 2018 he participated in an investigation of Happy 9 Day Spa. On that date he entered the establishment in an undercover capacity and posing as a customer and was greeted by Jing Hou. Ms. Hou collected his money, led him to a massage room, and left the room while he undressed and lay face down on the massage table with a towel covering his buttocks. Ms. Hou then re-entered the room and began the massage.
- During the massage when Detective Bernardo turned over onto his back, Ms. Hou

removed the towel and exposed his entire genitals. After several minutes, Ms. Hou asked Detective Bernardo if he wanted a "hand job," while making a hand gesture simulating manual stimulation of the penis. Detective Bernardo asked how much and Ms. Hou stated it would be \$40 and \$60 if he wanted her to take her clothes off. Detective Bernardo indicated he would pay \$40 and Ms. Hou began massaging Detective Bernardo's penis with her hand and told him that he could touch her if he wanted to. Assisting officers then entered the establishment.

In opposition to the Suspension of Certificate, you submitted the following documents before the document deadline:

- Written Statement from Certificate Holder, received: June 29, 2019
- Santa Clara Superior Court, Order of Dismissal, filed: April 15, 2019
- Milpitas Police Department, Notice to Appear, No. M566974, dated: October 12, 2018
- CAMTC Suspension of Certificate, dated: March 27, 2019
- CAMTC Waiver of Filing Fee
- Email Correspondence

The hearing officers carefully considered all of the written evidence you submitted. The hearing officers also carefully evaluated your oral testimony. After careful consideration of all of the evidence in your case, the hearing officers find by a preponderance of the evidence that you were the owner and/or operator of Happy 9 Day Spa on October 12, 2018. The hearing officers further find by a preponderance of the evidence that during the course of a massage that Ms. Hou provided to Detective Bernardo that she engaged in the following conduct: she agreed to manually stimulate Detective Bernardo's penis in exchange for \$40; she agreed to manually stimulate Detective Bernardo's penis and take her clothes off in exchange for \$60; she accepted \$40 for the agreed upon sex act; and she manually stimulated Detective Bernardo's penis.

In opposition to the suspension of your certificate, you provided testimony at your oral hearing. During your oral hearing you admit that you were the owner and operator of Happy 9 Day Spa on October 12, 2018. Additionally, you admit that Ms. Hou was working on the premises of your establishment on October 12, 2018. Finally, you admit that as the owner of the establishment that you are entitled to receive a portion of the proceeds of each massage provided at your establishment.

During your oral hearing you testified that you did not believe that Ms. Hou engaged in the conduct set forth in Detective Bernardo's declaration. However, you also admit that you were not present at the establishment on the date of the incident. Therefore, the hearing officers find that you lack personal knowledge as to what occurred in the room during the course of the massage that Ms. Hou provided to Detective Bernardo. Additionally, you failed to provide a statement from Ms. Hou denying the conduct or providing details of the massage from her point of view or providing details that contradict the statements set forth in Detective Bernardo's declaration.

Additionally, during your oral hearing you argued that the criminal case against Ms. Hou was dismissed. However, the fact that the charges stemming from this incident were ultimately dismissed is not relevant as to whether Ms. Hou engaged in the conduct set forth in Detective Bernardo's declaration on October 12, 2018. In determining whether or not to pursue prosecution in a particular case, a prosecutor has many different factors to consider. These factors are based upon a variety of issues, including the extremely high evidentiary standard that a prosecutor is held to in a criminal case. The legal standard in a criminal matter is "beyond a reasonable doubt," which is a higher evidentiary standard than the "preponderance of the evidence" standard that is the legal standard required for suspension of your certification. Additionally, a prosecutor must prove that all of the elements of a crime have been met, including payment for the sexual act, while engaging in unprofessional conduct is a different legal standard. Therefore, the fact that Ms. Hou's matter was dismissed in criminal court does not mean that the prosecutor did not believe the allegations contained in Detective Bernardo's declaration, or that the conduct described in Detective Bernardo's declaration did not occur. Nor does it mean that you did not engage in unprofessional conduct in violation of CAMTC's law.

As the trier of fact, the hearing officers are charged with weighing the evidence before it, assessing credibility, and making findings of fact. In his declaration, signed under the penalty of perjury, Detective Bernardo states that Ms. Hou committed an act punishable as a sexually related crime on October 12, 2018, under the guise of a massage. The sworn declaration submitted by Detective Bernardo was drafted and signed by an officer of the law with no known motive to lie. As an officer of the law, Detective Bernardo knows what it means to make a statement under penalty of perjury and is also intimately aware of the dire consequences of committing perjury, including loss of his job and benefits and criminal prosecution. You on the other hand have a motive to be untruthful about what occurred on October 12, 2018. Additionally, the hearing officers find that you were not present during the course of Detective Bernardo's massage and that you lack personal knowledge of what occurred. On the other hand, the hearing officers find that Detective Bernardo's declaration contains specific details that provide additional indicia of reliability. The hearing officers therefore find by a preponderance of the evidence that the declaration of Detective Bernardo is credible and that the conduct set forth in his declaration did, in fact, occur.

Therefore, after weighing all of the evidence in your case, including an assessment of the credibility of the officer and your oral testimony, the hearing officers find by a preponderance of the evidence that you were the owner and/or operator of Happy 9 Day Spa on October 12, 2018. The hearing officers further find by a preponderance of the evidence that on October 12, 2018, a massage provider working on the premises of your massage establishment engaged in acts punishable as a sexually related crime during the course of a massage she provided to Detective Bernardo when she: agreed to manually stimulate Detective Bernardo's penis in exchange for \$40; agreed to manually stimulate Detective Bernardo's penis and take her clothes off in exchange for \$60; accepted \$40 for the agreed upon sex act; and when she manually stimulated Detective Bernardo's penis. Based on the foregoing, the hearing officers find by a preponderance of the evidence that you committed acts punishable as a sexually related crime

in that as the owner and/or operator of Happy 9 Day Spa, you allowed these acts to occur on the premises of the establishment, you facilitated the activity, and you were in a position to benefit from the conduct in that you admit that you receive a portion of the proceeds of each massage provided at your establishment.

Therefore, based on the evidence before it, the hearing officers have decided to leave the suspension, placed on your certificate on March 22, 2019, in place. The decision of the hearing officers is final. Please note that the findings made by the hearing officers herein, do not preclude CAMTC from initiating further disciplinary proceedings against you in the future in relation to this incident.

9.10.030 (B) CAMTC Certificate or Exemption Required: NO information was provided by the City around the process to obtain an "exemption" for the long term employees that qualified for it. To hold the business owner responsible for the failure of the City is wrong.

9.10.200 (A) Owner / Manager Not Present: The permit coordinator was told multiple times that my husband was the Manager in absence. At the time of the Inspection, my husband was present and the person who called me to tell me to come to the shop. IF the new requirement is that it be in writing, that falls clearly on the Permit Coordinator for failing to do so.

9.10.200 (E) Display of CAMTC Certificate: ALL required Business Licenses, Permits and Certificates were posted on the lobby entry. The two other individuals without CAMTC, are the same two individuals who would have been eligible for the exemption. should the City have provided proper notification as noted in 'A' above.

9.10.210 (F) Toilet Facilities: It is unknown when this provision was put in place, however Yubo did not know about it. It is valid there was NO single service towel dispenser, there WAS a permanent soap dispenser which had malfunctioned a week prior, and Yubo had temporarily placed a "pump soap dispenser" on the sink as a short term solution pending the replacement of the permanent one.

Re: Ordinance Revising Roseville Municipal Code Chapter 9.1 – Massage Services

To Whom It May Concern:

We are reaching out to notify you of an important change to Chapter 9.10 of the Roseville Municipal Code, titled, "Massage Services." As you may be aware, Chapter 9.10 of the Municipal Code regulates massage business activity within the City of Roseville's jurisdictional boundaries. This includes regulations regarding massage business permitting, massage business operations, and education and training requirements for massage service providers.

On August 7, 2024, the Roseville City Council adopted an ordinance that, among other changes, modifies the minimum training and education requirements for those who may provide massage services within the City. Below is a brief summary of the key changes to Chapter 9.10:

- Any person providing massage services within Roseville must hold a valid certificate from CAMTC or obtain an exemption from the City.
- If a proposed massage business will be operated at a premises that is leased or rented, the owner of the premises must be informed that massage services are being provided.
- A massage business permit applicant must submit the names and birthdays of every person who will be providing massage therapy services at the proposed business.
- Any new massage business is prohibited from operating in the same location of massage business previously closed within the prior 3 years due to criminal activity.
- Any person who has their massage business permit revoked must wait 3 years before applying for a new permit.
- Any person denied a massage business permit is prohibited from reapplying within 2 years after the denial unless the applicant can show a material change in their situation justifying issuance of a permit.

- Massage businesses must report the hiring or termination of any massage professional (both employees and independent contractors) to the police department within 7 days of the hiring or termination.
- Windows that allow the lobby area of a massage business to be viewed from the exterior of the building may not be covered and the lobby area must be visible from the exterior of the massage business.
- Any violation of Chapter 9.10 is a misdemeanor. However, this does not require that the City criminally prosecute every violation of Chapter 9.10 as a misdemeanor, and the City still has discretion to pursue other non-criminal remedies, like administrative fines.

Please be aware that the requirement that all massage professionals be CAMTC certified does not go into effect until January 1, 2025. All of the other requirements noted above go into effect on September 6, 2024. Also, please be aware that the City of Roseville requires a business license and a massage business permit in order to operate a massage business establishment within the City. Please contact me at the information provided below if you need assistance obtaining your business license or massage business permit.

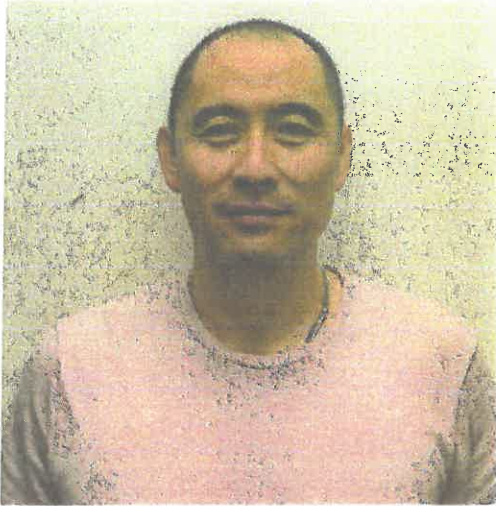
Title 2. Administration

Chapter 2.50. ADMINISTRATIVE CITATIONS

§ 2.50.080. Hearing procedure.

- A. A hearing shall be set for a date that is not less than 15 days and not more than 90 days from the date that the request for hearing is initially filed in accordance with the provisions of this chapter.
- B. The city attorney's office, in its sole discretion, may reschedule a hearing one-time at the request of any party for any reason, so long as such request is made not less than three business days before the hearing date. If a party requests a new hearing date other than the assigned date and that date is more than 90 days from the date of the initial request for hearing, the request shall be denied. Any requests to reschedule a hearing date must be provided to the city attorney's office not less than three business days prior to the date of the hearing.
- C. The city attorney's office, in its sole discretion, may reschedule a hearing upon a request of any party and a finding that there is good cause to reschedule the hearing. Whether good cause exists to reschedule a hearing is solely within the discretion of the city attorney's office. Any requests to reschedule a hearing date must be provided to the city attorney's office not less than three business days prior to the date of the hearing.
- D. At the hearing, the party contesting the administrative citation shall be given the opportunity to testify and to present evidence concerning the administrative citation.
- E. The failure of any recipient of an administrative citation to appear at the administrative citation hearing shall constitute a failure to exhaust administrative remedies.
- F. The administrative citation and any additional report submitted by the enforcement officer shall constitute prima facie evidence of the respective facts contained in those documents.
- G. The hearing panel may continue the hearing and request additional information from the enforcement officer or the recipient of the citation prior to issuing a written decision.
