Chairperson for the February 26, 2026 hearing was Connor Milligan.

4. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Chairperson Connor Milligan led the audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

5. PUBLIC COMMENT

No one from the public offered any comments.

6. SWEAR IN

Chairperson Connor Milligan administered the Oath to those in attendance who would be offering testimony at the hearing.

7. MATTERS TO BE HEARD

7.1. Administrative Citation No.: 22103

Appellant: Karin Bullard, 74 Hawk Crest Court, Roseville, CA 95678

- Roseville Municipal Code Section 7.12.010, Leash Law
- Roseville Municipal Code Section 7.12.050, Aggressive Behavior
- Roseville Municipal Code Section 7.16.010, Licensing

The appellant, Karin Bullard, was not present at 3:00 p.m. The item was trailed to allow her 15 minutes from the commencement of the hearing to appear per the Administrative Hearing Procedures

The appellant arrived at 3:13 p.m. and this matter was heard after Item 7.2 on the agenda. The appellant was sworn in by Chairperson Connor Milligan.

A. Staff Report:

Animal Control Officer Marissa Terry offered testimony regarding the Staff Report (Exhibit 7.1-A) and Notice of Violation (Exhibit 7.1-B).

Per RMC Section 2.50.060(D), the Staff Report was submitted to the City of Roseville Attorney's Office prior to the hearing and was provided to the Appellant and the panel members in advance of the hearing.

Complainant's Statement:

Complainant Sunday McCullum presented evidence entered into the minutes as Exhibit 7.1-C and offered testimony in support of the complaint.

Exhibit 7.1-C:

Text exchange of November 16, 2025 between Complainant Sunday McCullum and Elliot.

B. Appellant's Response:

Request for Hearing:

Appellant's Request for Hearing form (Exhibit 7.1-D) was received by the Roseville City Attorney's Office on November 29, 2025 and was provided to the panel in advance of the hearing for review.

Appellant Karin Bullard testified and presented Exhibit 7.1-E, in support of the appeal.

Exhibit 7.1-E:

Rabies Certificate dated December 08, 2025

Letter from City of Roseville Animal Licensing dated December 05, 2025 confirming receipt of \$25 payment for licensing, but license could not be issued due to the rabies certificate has or will expire soon.

C. Rebuttals and Panel Questions:

No rebuttal testimony was offered.

Complainant Sunday McCullum answered panel questions.

Appellant Karin Bullard answered panel questions.

D. Panel Discussion and Decision:

The panel discussed the evidence and testimony presented for Administrative Citation No.: 22103.

Senior Deputy Attorney Travis Cochran asked Animal Control Officer Terry if she had reviewed the status of the license with PetData prior to the hearing. Officer Terry responded that she had checked the status of the license and it still showed incomplete.

A motion was made by Charles Sandoval and seconded by Louise Santiago to deny the appeal and uphold the violations because the City/Complainant proved by a preponderance of the evidence that the violations occurred and that the appellant is the responsible party.

The motion passed with the following vote:

Chairperson Connor Milligan signed the decision form (Exhibit 7.1-F), asked the Appellant to see staff for the paperwork, and informed the parties that they may file a petition for review with the Superior Court in Placer County within 20 days.

D. Panel Discussion and Decision:

The panel discussed the evidence and testimony presented for Administrative Citation No.: 22162.

Senior Deputy City Attorney advised the panel that they are allowed to continue hearings if they needed additional information to proceed with the hearing.

As the panel agreed that additional information was needed from the Appellant to proceed with the hearing, a motion was made by Charles Sandoval and seconded by Louise Santiago to direct staff to reschedule this matter for a new hearing date.

The motion passed with the following vote:

Chairperson Connor Milligan advised Appellant that a new hearing date will be coordinated with Appellant and staff.

After completion of the hearing, it was determined that Appellant is now in compliance with the Municipal Code and the underlying citation dismissed, and therefore, no additional hearing will be scheduled.

Violation: RMC § 7.12.010 Leash law (1 count)

No person shall permit or allow any dog to run at large. This section may be cited as the "leash law."

RMC § 7.04.060 at large defined.

"At large" means the following:

1.
 Off the premises of the owner or the person having care, custody, control or possession of the dog unless such dog is restrained by a leash or adequate enclosure. The leash shall not exceed six feet in length and shall be of sufficient strength to restrain the dog and must be held continuously by a responsible person capable of controlling the dog.

2.
 On the premises of the owner or the person having care, custody, control or possession of the dog unless such dog is restrained by means adequate and sufficient to prevent the dog from leaving the premises or under the control and in the immediate presence of the owner or person having care, custody, control or possession of the dog.

B.
 A dog shall not be considered "at large" if it is:

1.
 A guide dog, signal dog, or service dog as defined in Section 54.1 of the California Civil Code, as may be amended, while performing the duties it is trained to perform;

2.
 Assisting or in training to assist a peace officer who is engaged in law enforcement duties;

3.
 Enrolled and actively participating in a commercial dog training or obedience class, exhibition or competition;

4.
 Within the confines of a city-designated dog park and licensed pursuant to this chapter;

5.
 Securely confined in a vehicle.

RMC § 7.12.050 Aggressive behavior (1 count)

No person shall permit or allow any dog, when unprovoked, to engage in any behavior that requires a defensive action by any person to prevent bodily injury when the person and the dog are not on the property of the owner or keeper of the dog.

RMC § 7.16.010 Licensing (1 count)

A dog or car over the age of four months must be licensed according to the provisions of this chapter.

Narrative:

On November 15th, 2025, at approximately 1545 hours, Roseville Police Animal Control received a telephone call from Sunday McCullum who reported that a possible Pitbull type dog that was white in color had chased her and was growling until she got into her vehicle.

On November 15th, at approximately 1605 hours Animal Control Officer (ACO) M. Terry spoke to Sunday via telephone. Sunday provided the following statement in summary; Sunday was visiting a friend who resides at 66 Hawk Crest Ct. When Sunday was leaving the residence a large possible Pitbull type dog, white in color with a dark patch over its eye charged her growling. Sunday screamed and the dog stopped but then charged again. Sunday had to kick at the dog and yell at it to get back to create enough distance to get into her vehicle. Once safe in the vehicle Sunday texted her friend that she was visiting. Sunday claimed that her friend said that the dog had been an issue in the area for a while. Sunday requested that an ACO issue a citizen's citation on her behalf for RMC 7.12.010 Leash Law and RMC 7.12.050 Aggressive Behavior.

On November 15th, at approximately 1811 hours, ACO M. Terry spoke to dog owners Karin Bullard and Gerry Stout on speaker phone. Neither Karin nor Gerry were home at the time of the incident. They own a dog named "Sunny" a ten-year-old, spayed female, white and black, Pitbull terrier that is approximately 40-44 pounds. Karin claimed that "Sunny" is an escape artist and gets out a lot but stays in the court and does not go far. Karin said that "Sunny" is a friendly dog that gets along with all the neighbors and plays with their dogs. Karin claimed that one of the neighbors refuses to meet "Sunny" and that she keeps going onto that neighbor's property out of curiosity. ACO M. Terry explained that a citizen citation was being issued, and Karin wanted the citation issued to her. Karin claimed that "Sunny" has never growled and that "Sunny" possibly ran up to Sunday barking. ACO. M Terry mailed a license application and ACO Pamphlet to Karin.

Karin was issued a citation for RMC 7.16.010 Licensing. On November 30th, Karin paid for a license for "Sunny" but did not provide a rabies certificate to complete the license.

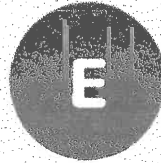

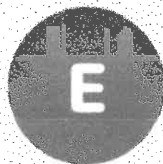

Narrative:

On June 25th, 2025, at 0705 hours, Roseville Police Animal Control received a complaint regarding a dog barking at the address of 131 Nevada Ave. Animal Control Officer (ACO) Supervisor S. Cooper mailed a warning letter for noise, a license application, an ACO pamphlet to the dog owner.

On July 17th, 2025, at approximately 0721 hours, Roseville Police Animal Control received a second barking complaint for the address of 131 Nevada Ave. ACO M. Terry left a voicemail for Maria advising her of second noise complaint. At approximately 0757 hours Maria Trunzo called Roseville Police Animal Control dispatch and requested that an ACO return her call. ACO M. Terry spoke with Maria who claimed that her dog does not bark for more than 20 minutes within an hour's time frame. ACO M. Terry advised Maria that her dog still needed to be licensed, and Maria stated that she would be moving out of Roseville within the month.

On August 25th, 2025, at approximately 0356 hours, Roseville Police Animal Control received a third barking complaint for the address of 131 Nevada Ave. ACO Supervisor S. Cooper spoke to Maria on the telephone who stated that she had been in the hospital and would have her daughter stay with the dog that evening. ACO Supervisor S. Cooper mailed an additional license application to Maria to license her dog.

On September 5th, 2025, Maria had still not licensed her dog. ACO M. Terry issued a citation for RMC 7.16.010 Licensing x 1.

On November 20th, 2025, Maria had still not licensed her dog. ACO M. Terry issued a citation for RMC 7.16.010 Licensing x 1.

As of January 14th, 2026, Maria had still not licensed her dog. Maria paid for a license on December 10th, 2025, but failed to provide a rabies certificate to complete the licensing.
