Agenda Items: Speakers have five (5) minutes to address items that are listed on the agenda.



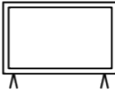

5.4. Libraries and Culture – Year in Review – 2025

City Librarian Narinder Sufi shared statistics and highlights of the Libraries and Culture Division. Library visitation for the 2025 calendar year increased over the previous year by 7% and was 438,416. Circulation had an increase of 13% and was 1,624,465. Program participation increased by 53% and the number of programs offered increased 18%. Museum visitation in 2025 was 15,167. Cultural arts projects included the Johnson Pool Mural, Placer Valley Soccer Complex Sculpture and Mural, Weber Park Mural as well as the signature event titled *Inspire*. Maidu Museum & Historic site held a collaborative exhibition with Sierra Native Alliance titled *Walking in our Moccs and Momin Wene / Medicine Water* in partnership with Shingle Springs.

5.5. Library Programs and Events in 2025

Library Supervisor Cambria Evans, Librarians Nathan Garcia and Magaly Coronado shared an overview of various learning, reading, education and engagement opportunities offered in the libraries during the last year. Library Programming teams were reorganized in 2025. A Youth Programming Librarian oversees storytimes, preschool and school age programming, reading challenges, tours, school outreach as well as liaison for Adventure Club and the homeschool community. A Teen/Adult Programming Librarian oversees the Teen advisory Board, teen programming, Adult Book Clubs, Local Author Series, Crafter's Corner and Push Pause, middle school, high school and senior adult outreach, community special events and literacy-specific programming. In 2025 the library had 628 Storytime Sessions with 34,946 participants, 13 STEAM related programs, 25 family programs and 148 patron-led programs. The library held 85 tours with 2,723 participants as well as *Read with a Mermaid*, *Read with a Conductor*, *Tot Time* at the Fountains, Summer Lunch Outreach and *Books and Blankets* with Placer County of Education. In 2025 127 Adult programs were held with 1,018 participants. Programs included Local Author Talk series, Crafter's Corner series, new book club at Riley, Wreath with Us, ValenCrimes, Dice & Decks, Healthy Mind Healthy Wallet and Literacy programs.

5.6. Libraries & Culture Report

City Librarian Narinder Sufi provided updates on the Libraries & Culture Division operations including libraries, Maidu Museum & Historic Site, and cultural arts efforts. The Roseville Public Library is participating in the State Library Initiative *Every Story Counts*. This initiative collects stories from the public about how and why they use the library. Stories may be submitted online or on paper. Another State Library Initiative is currently being worked on that is about how the community benefits when public libraries are working together

and sharing services.

The City of Roseville websites and emails are changing in March to roseville.ca.gov to bring us in line with all government agencies throughout the state.

The community art event *Letters to the Sky* was a great success with over 300 submissions. Calls for mural submissions for the Downtown Library staircase and Placer Valley Soccer Complex have closed. The current exhibition at the Maidu Museum & Historic Site closes on January 31, 2026.
