Agenda Items: Speakers have five (5) minutes to address items that are listed on the agenda.





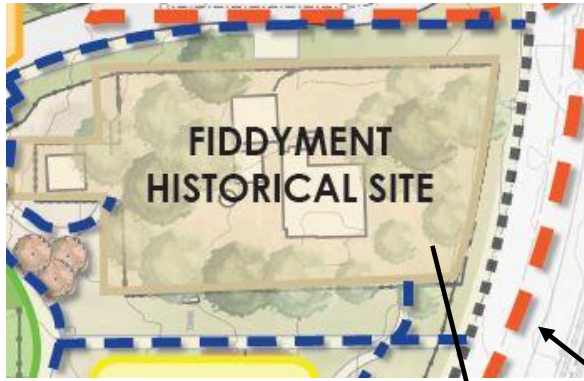

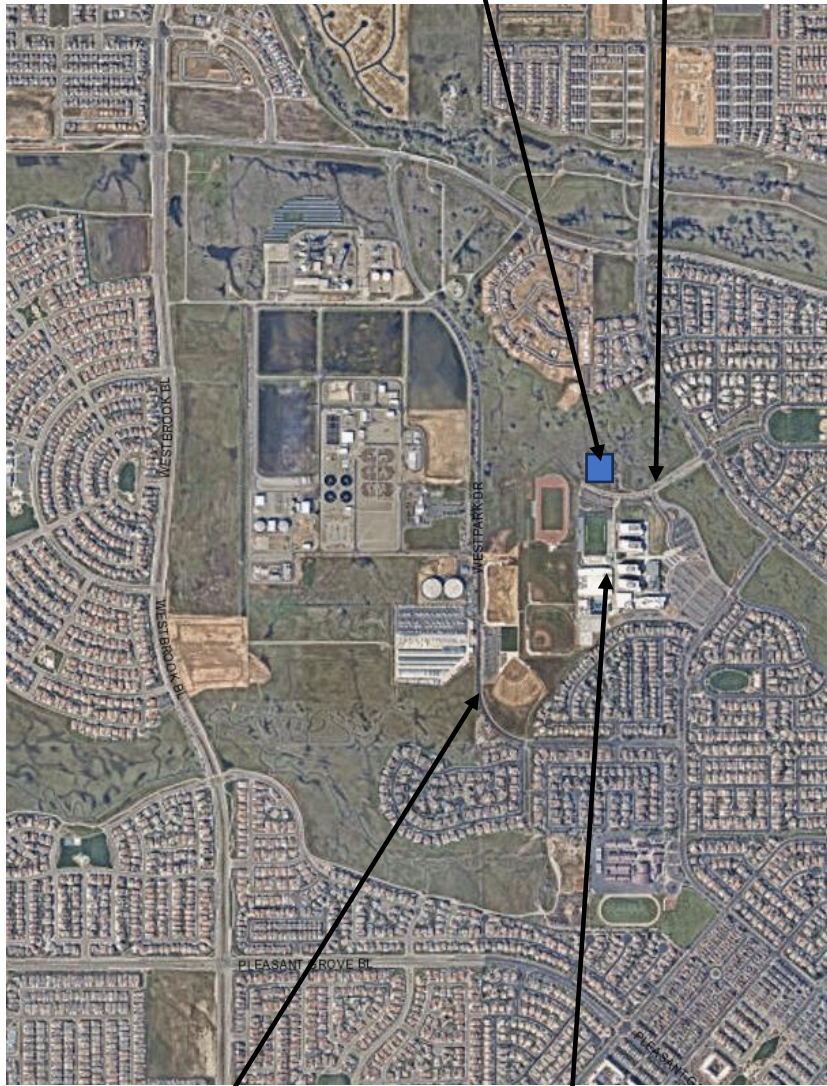
